Challenge in this writ petition is to the order dated 03.10.2019 (Annexure P-13) passed by the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Moga, in exercise of power under Section 216 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994.

An efficacious alternative remedy, by way of appeal, is provided to the petitioner against the aforesaid order under Section 216 (3) of the enactment. As the petitioner seeks to raise certain factual aspects which are incapable of resolution in a writ petition, she would be better advised to raise the same before the statutory appellate authority.

This writ petition is accordingly dismissed leaving it open to the petitioner to take recourse to the statutory appellate remedy provided to her in accordance with law.
