Case has been taken up through Video Conferencing.

The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.514 dated 30.11.2019 under Sections 392/201 IPC registered at P.S. Civil Lines, District Gurugram.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was not arrested from the spot and he has been involved in the present case on the disclosure statement made by the co-accused before the police, which is not admissible as per Section 27 of the Indian Evidence Act. He has further pointed out that co-accused Aziz Azharuddin @ Gullam, has been granted bail by the trial Court vide order dated 6.5.2020.

Learned State Counsel has stated that the petitioner has been in custody since December, 2019 and recovery of Rs.1500/- has already been effected from him. It

is further contended that though the challan has been presented, yet no witness has been examined thus far.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the present application is allowed and the petitioner is granted regular bail. Bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
