This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 14.10.2015 passed by Ms. Mandeep Kaur, Addl. Sessions Judge, Kapurthala by which maintenance granted by the Magistrate @ ₹2500 per month has been enhanced to ₹8000/- per month.

By an order dated 13.07.2016 the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court had directed the petitioner to deposit a sum of ₹60,000/- within a fortnight and the recovery beyond Rs. 5000/- per month had been stayed.

The case was taken up on subsequent hearings and during the proceedings appearance was made on behalf of the respondent through counsel who apprised the Court that the petitioner had not complied with the order dated 13.07.2016 with regard to deposit of ₹60,000/- and on the said statement, the stay granted by the Court on 13.07.2016 was vacated on 05.05.2017. This Court was again seized of the matter and on 02.08.2017 last opportunity had been allowed to learned counsel for the petitioner to

address arguments.

Today despite the matter having been called twice, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

As per the note of the Registry dated 24.01.2020, arrears have not been deposited so far.

Consequently, this Court find no ground to interfere in the order so passed and deem it appropriate to dismiss the present petition for want of prosecution.
