1. Applicant-wife seeks transfer of petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 bearing HMA No.1041/2018 titled as “Jagsir Singh Vs. Jyoti” pending in the Court of Learned District Judge, Family Court, Moga to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Hisar.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that complaint under Section 12 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 against the respondent-husband filed by the applicant-wife is already pending at Hisar.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant further submits that applicant is residing at Village Lohari, Ragho, Tehsil Narnaund, District Hisar with her old age parents. She has no source of income. The distance from her village to Moga is about 300 kms.

Therefore, it is difficult for her to go to Moga on each date of hearing.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent appears and submits that he has no objection if the petition in question is transferred to Hisar.

5. Without going into the merits of the transfer application and keeping in view the consent given by both the learned counsel for the parties, the present application is allowed. The petition in question pending before the Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Moga is ordered to be withdrawn from that Court and is transferred to the District Judge, Hisar for its disposal in accordance with law by the Court concerned.
