For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed and
the main petition is taken up today itself.

CRM-M-11680-2020

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail
to the petitioner in case FIR No.96 dated 04.07.2019, under Sections 21 and
29 of Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short
'NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station, Nakodar Sadar, District Jalandhar
Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was
in jail since 04.01.2019 and the present FIR has been registered on

consequent upon a disclosure statement of Gurwinder Kaur @ Gagan and thereafter, the petitioner was taken into custody in this case on 10.07.2019.

Learned State counsel is not disputing the above facts. She states that even though, the petitioner was arrested on the disclosure statement made by Gurwinder Kaur @ Gagan, but he (petitioner) is facing another trial and hence, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Heard.

In this case, three co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 28.01.2020 (Annexure P-4).

Keeping in view the role attributed to the petitioner, period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that the trial will take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that no purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.
