GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. Today, at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition qua petitioner No.6.
2. In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition qua petitioner No.6 is dismissed as withdrawn.
3. Petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.16, dated 1.2.2019, Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 341, 379-B, 506, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties.
4. Vide order dated 18.3.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

5. Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khadur Sahib, has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners No.1 to 5 and 7/accused Ganga Singh, Baljinder Singh, Rajwinder Singh, Gurjit Singh, Gurmit Singh, Lovepreet Singh @ Labha and also of complainant Daljit Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.
6. The complainant in his statement has specifically stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
7. The learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khadur Sahib, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
8. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.16, dated 1.2.2019, Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 341, 379-B, 506, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners No.1 to 5 and 7.
