Main writ petition

Mr. Subhash Ahuja, learned counsel for the Panjab University,
would fairly concede that the issue raised in this writ petition stands settled
by the judgment dated 25.11.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No.8057 of
2004 titled **'Janak Sharma and others V/s. The Panjab University,
Chandigarh'** and batch.

For reasons alike as were stated in the aforesaid judgment and

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in terms thereof, this writ petition is disposed of directing Univesity to consider the case of the petitioners for regulairzation within three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. In the event the petitoners services are regularised, they shall be accorded all admissible benefits subject to their eligibility. It is also made clear that the fact that they approached this Court would not be held against the petitioners for being regularized in the service.
