Amandeep Kaur and Dalbir Singh, the petitioners before this Court, claim themselves to be major. Petitioner No.1-Amandeep Kaur claims that she had married earlier and her first husband unfortunately expired on 31.05.2016 and his death certificate is Annexure P3. She further claims that her parents were performing her marriage against her wishes with a boy whom she did not like and therefore, she left her maternal home and performed marriage with petitioner No.2-Dalbir Singh on 17.03.2020. The petitioners pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondent No.4 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent No.4. They have placed on record marriage certificate and photographs, Annexures P-5 and P-4, respectively evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation, Annexure P-6 to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, the petition is disposed of with a

direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-6 and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
