Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.29 dated 03.03.2020, registered under Section 304 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and under Section 15(3) of Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 at Police Station Shambu, District Patiala, Punjab.

On 11.05.2020, following order was passed by this

Court:-

“The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners relies upon pendency of CRM-M No.11687 of 2020 titled 'Garja Singh Rathore and another Vs. State of Punjab' to contend that the petitioners are not manufacturers of 'Cold Best-PC Syrup'. Petitioner No.1 is a registered medical practitioner registered with Government Ayurvedic and Unani Medical Council, Bihar under Bihar Development of Ayurvedic and Unani System of Medicine Act, 1951. He purchased the aforesaid medicine/syrup from an authorized dealer/seller namely Shiva Medical Agency, Ambala vide invoice dated 25.01.2020. M/s Digital Vision (Pharmaceutical Company) is the manufacturer of the aforesaid syrup, against whom number of cases have been registered.

Notice of motion for 14.07.2020.

Interim order in the same terms as passed in CRM-M No.11687 of 2020.

To be heard along with CRM-M No.11687 of 2020.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mohar Singh submits that in pursuance of aforesaid order, petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required in further investigation of the case, therefore, order dated 11.05.2020 is made absolute. However, petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer.
