Case taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.10 dated 14.02.2020, registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 420 IPC at Police Station Women Cell, District Bathinda.

The FIR in question arose from a matrimonial discord between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as also the complainant submit that the parties have amicably resolved their dispute through a written compromise and on the basis thereof they have sought divorce under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljeet Singh submits that under the interim orders passed by this Court the petitioner has joined the investigation and that her custodial interrogation is not required.

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In view of the above, the order of this Court dated 21.05.2020, granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.
