The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 436 dated 08.10.2019 registered under Sections 148, 323, 324, 452, 506 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Chandhuth, District Palwal.

Heard.

On 04.08.2020, the following order was passed:-

“The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to Annexure P-3 Medical Report of the petitioner and states that it is a case of version and cross-version. During the pendency of the present FIR, petitioner has married with the daughter of the complainant, namely, Tarisha and she is residing with him.

Post again on 8.9.2020.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 6.8.2020 at 11.30 a.m. in the concerned police station to join investigation.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1) that he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2) that he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
- 3) that he shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.”*

Learned State counsel on instructions from Inspector Devender Singh submits that in pursuance of the order dated 04.08.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 04.08.2020 is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed
