The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.38 dated 21.02.2020 under Sections 380, 411, 457 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Kaithal, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that she along with other accused had stolen ₹23,500/- cash, 02 account books and two ATM cards. He, however, contends that the petitioner, who is 20 year old lady, has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner is in custody for over 03 months; she is not involved in any other case and co-accused, namely, Prabhu Kohli, has been granted regular bail by the trial Court on 06.01.2020.

Learned State counsel states that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined so far.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is 20 years old lady; she is in custody for over 03 months; she is not involved in any other case; the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
