With the consent of learned counsel for both the parties, the matter is being taken up and heard via video conferencing.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that though he has challenged the eligibility clause in the tender notice relating to disqualification of those persons who already possessed a licence for running a shop in the PGI, the said disqualification as far as the petitioner is concerned, no longer exists. He submits that he has moved an application before the respondent-authorities for considering his claim for shop No.3 on account of this fact and that application is pending decision before the authorities.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-PGI submits that the application filed by the petitioner shall be considered and decided by the respondent-authorities in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a period of one week taking into consideration the subsequent events that have occurred and the situation that has arisen subsequent to the filing of the application.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel appearing for the respondent-PGI, the petition stands disposed of.
