Petition has been filed for anticipatory bail in FIR No.20 dated 10.03.2020 under Section 498-A of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Ghuman, District Batala, Punjab.

In view of the order dated 29.09.2020 report of the mediation proceedings which had taken place at Gurdaspur, had been received vide letter dated 19.10.2020. The parties have thus agreed to live separately and petitioner has agreed to pay Rs.8 lakhs in the settlement of the claim of complainant. The proposal is to file a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act and on the first motion sum of Rs.3 lakhs is to be paid to the wife Inderjit Kaur. The custody of minor daughter Jasmer Kaur will remain with the petitioner and even visiting rights as such have been arranged for. Parties are to also file petition for quashing of the FIR.

In such circumstances, counsels are agreed that the interim order as granted on 22.05.2020 be confirmed.

Ordered accordingly.

It is further directed that sum of Rs.25,000/- which was directed to be deposited with office of this Court will be credited to the account of respondent No.2-Inderjit Kaur as litigation expenses as per her application and details of which have already been furnished to the office, instead of payment through the counsel as had been directed on 29.09.2020.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
