GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

At the time of issuance of notice in the main case, *dasti* notices were ordered to be issued subject to furnishing requisite number of copies of the paper-book, registered cover, process fee and incidental expenses, if any, within two weeks. It was specifically ordered that in case of non-compliance, the petition would be dismissed for want of prosecution. The operative portion of order dated 21.5.2019 reads as follows:

“Let notice to the respondent-state as well as newly added respondents be issued for 13.09.2019, through ordinary process, registered cover and dasti as well as on furnishing, requisite number of copies of the paper-book, registered cover, process fee and incidental expenses, if any, within two weeks.

In case of non-compliance of this order in its letter and spirit, this petition shall be dismissed for want of prosecution.”

As per office report the newly added respondents could not be served for want of process fee.

In view of the aforestated non-compliance of the requisite directions and in view of the order dated 21.5.2019, the petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
