The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Mr. Kuldeep Tiwari, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana puts in appearance on behalf of the State on his own.

Petitioner Naseeb who is custody in case bearing FIR No.372 dated 08.07.2018 under Sections 306/34 IPC pertaining to Police Station City Jind, Haryana, has sought interim bail for a period of 45 days on account of compassionate grounds as his wife Anita is suffering from Cancer, to enable him to look after her and the family.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Raj Kumar has duly acceded to the stand of the petitioner and which is duly supported by the medical documents issued by Pt. B.D. Sharma Post Graduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak. Keeping in view that it is admitted stand of the two sides that the wife of the petitioner is suffering from cancer and

that the petitioner being husband on account of their relationship and the fact that this will facilitate the petitioner to look after his wife and to take care of the family in such a stage of global pandemic, taking a lenient view in the light of overwhelming stand it would be in the interest of justice to allow the petitioner interim bail with effect from 06.05.2020 to 21.05.2020 subject to furnishing of personal bonds in the sum of ₹1.00 lac with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jind and undertaking that he will not interfere in the fair trial or influence the prosecution witnesses. The petitioner shall surrender before the Superintendent, District Jail, Jind on 22.05.2020 at 10.00 a.m.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
