Case taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition the petitioner seeks the grant of concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.41 dated 10.04.2020, registered under Sections 452, 427, 323, 506, 188 and 34 IPC at Police Station Nandhgarh, District Bathinda.

The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner alongwith 25 unknown persons entered the complainant's house; gave threats and beatings and caused damage to her car.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case; she is not involved in any other criminal case; the allegations with regard to giving beatings to the complainant and causing damage to her car are vague and that under the interim order of this Court dated 05.05.2020 the petitioner has not only joined the investigation but has also cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurtej Singh, submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order of this Court the petitioner has joined the investigation; has fully cooperated with the investigating agency and that her custodial interrogation is no longer required by the State.

The petitioner is a lady aged 47 years; is not involved in any other criminal case; has not only joined investigation but has also fully cooperated with the investigating agency and as per learned State counsel her custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the order of this Court dated 05.05.2020, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.
