The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No. 99 dated 19.5.2018, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120 B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012, at Police Station City Moga.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that the name of the petitioner has unnecessarily been dragged in the matter. Even as per the allegations of the prosecution, the petitioner was only an employee in a company being run by Charanjit Singh. The allegations against the petitioner is that she used to prepare false documents for sending the candidates abroad for study purposes; on the asking of Charanjit Singh. However, Charanjit Singh has already been granted bail pending trial in this case. The petitioner is in custody in this case

since 1.11.2019. Although the petitioner is having another case of similar nature against her, however, in that case she has already been granted bail. Therefore, as of today, the petitioner is not in custody in any other case; except the present one.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner has been preparing false documents for money. However, it is not disputed that the petitioner is only an employee in the company of Charanjit Singh; and further; that Charanjit Singh has already been released on bail.

In view of the above, but without commenting any further on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to her furnishings bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
