This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.109, dated 13.03.2020, under Sections 420/120-B IPC, registered at police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

On 05.05.2020, while issuing notice of motion order the following order was passed:

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Punjab.

Mr. G.G. Dhuriwala, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In the event of the arrest of the petitioner in FIR No.109, dated 13.03.2020, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station City Ferozepur, she be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting

Officer.

The concession, is however, subject to the conditions as prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 09.07.2020.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Amarjit Kaur apprises the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

In view of the above, the instant petition is allowed. Order dated 05.05.2020 is made absolute.
