All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Pursuant to the orders passed in these two petitions on 05.05.2020 and 08.06.2020, the petitioners were ordered to be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/Duty Magistrate concerned, with all learned counsel being *ad idem* that they have been so admitted.

Mr. Chahar, learned State counsel, submits that nine injuries were received by the complainant at the hands of 6 persons, but on query, he submits

that the grievous injury was on the finger of the complainant, with the other injuries (even those on the head), being simple injuries.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in fact another co-accused, i.e. one Vikram, has also been admitted to bail by the trial court.

That being so, for the reasons already recorded in the order of this court dated 05.05.2020 (in CRM-M-12001 of 2020), looking at the period of custody of the petitioners as also the nature of the injuries received, without making any comment whatsoever on the actual merits of the case, the petitions are allowed, with the orders dated 05.05.2020 and 08.06.2020 made absolute.
