LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 381 dated 17.03.2020 under Section 380IPC (later added Sections 381 and 411 IPC) registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

It is reiterated that the petitioner was a former employee of the complainant and that the petitioner has been involved in this FIR due to certain misunderstandings between the parties. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been now amicably resolved. The petitioner who is attributed with an offence punishable under Section 411 IPC is stated to have joined investigation. It is, thus, prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for the complainant verifies that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties.

Learned counsel for the State verifies that the petitioner has joined investigation. Custodial interrogation of the petitioner is clearly not required.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond or that he is likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if afforded anticipatory bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 06.05.2020 is made absolute.
