Since the charges are to be framed tomorrow before the trial court as per the instructions of the learned State counsel and otherwise the allegations against the petitioner are of defrauding a large number of people, without making any comment on the merits of the case, other than what has been observed by this court in the order dated 06.05.2020, this petition by which the petitioner has sought an interim bail is disposed of, with the question of extension of the interim bail granted being taken up in the accompanying petition.
