The matter has been taken up through Video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has made statement withdrawing the present petition qua petitioner no. 8. Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner no. 8.

Learned State Counsel submits that the petitioners No. 1,3,4, 5,6 & 7 have since joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made

absolute.

In the light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 24.7.2020 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioners No. 1,3,4, 5,6 & 7 shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition qua petitioners no. 2 and 8 is dismissed.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
