The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Learned State counsel submits that in consequence of interim order dated 06.05.2020, the petitioners have since joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and that they have no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 06.05.2020 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioners shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
