1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0079 dated 07.04.2020, registered under Sections 188, 341, 323, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 and 30 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

3. Vide order dated 06.05.2020, while taking note of the fact that in CRM-M-12007 of 2020, co-accused had been granted bail, the case was adjourned to 16.07.2020, while granting interim bail to the petitioners subject to their joining investigation within two weeks and complying with the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

4. Learned Sr. DAG, on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, states that pursuant to the orders of this Court dated 06.05.2020, the petitioners have joined investigation and that custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not necessary.

5. In the light of the position as noted above as also the fact that challan is yet to be filed, consequentially trial would take considerable period of time, conditional order dated 06.05.2020, is made absolute qua the petitioners. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. However, nothing stated hereinabove would be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
