This petition under Section 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and further to ensure that they may not be harassed by respondent Nos. 4 to 8, as the petitioners have solemnized marriage against the wishes of their parents on 15.01.2020.

On 24.04.2020, parents of petitioner No.1-Karamjeet Kaur took her away to their own house and did not let her come back to her matrimonial house. Thereafter, she managed to escape from the company of her parents and came to the house of petitioner No.2 on 30.04.2020. Since then, they are facing harassment and are apprehending danger to their personal life and liberty.

Learned State counsel, on telephonic instructions from SHO, Police Station, Rampura Phool, has informed that Karamjeet Kaur has now

they shall not be harassed by anyone.

Keeping in view the above situation, this petition is being disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, for protection, as per the instructions dated 10.08.2010 issued by the Home Department, Punjab, who will look into their grievance, if any.
