The petitioner is Accused No.3 in FIR No.08 dated 08.01.2020 on the file of Police Station Fatehabad City registered under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1985'). She seeks grant of regular bail.

Perusal of the record reflects that the three accused in FIR No.08 dated 08.01.2020 were allegedly apprehended at the Bus Stand, Fatehabad, in joint possession of 56 kilograms of Poppy Husk. The commercial quantity prescribed under the Act of 1985, insofar as Poppy Husk is concerned, is 50 kilograms. As the three accused were subjected to the charge together and are stated to have been acting in tandem, the

Provisions of Section 37 of the Act of 1985 would stand attracted.

Mr. Kuldeep Tiwari, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, would inform this Court that this is not the first such offence in which the petitioner was involved.

That being so, this Court finds no grounds to believe that the petitioner is not likely to commit a similar offence if granted bail.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
