1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.49 dated 13.03.2020, registered under Sections 323, 324, 34 of IPC, to which Sections 325 and 326 of IPC were added subsequently, at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 11.05.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and fully cooperated with the Police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

4. Learned DAG, Punjab, on instructions from *SI Harnaresh*

the petitioner joined investigation and was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the statement of learned DAG, Punjab, order dated 11.05.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
