Case taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition the petitioner seeks the grant of concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.17 dated 11.02.2020, registered under Section 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda.

The case of the prosecution is that illicit liquor has been recovered from the house of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case; he is not involved in any other criminal case and that under the interim order of this Court dated 12.05.2020 the petitioner has not only joined the investigation but has also cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the interim order of this Court the petitioner has not only joined investigation but has also fully cooperated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

The petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case; under the interim order of this Court he has not only joined the investigation but has also fully cooperated with the investigating agency and as per learned State counsel his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above, the order of this Court dated 12.05.2020, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.
