On 12.05.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.11 dated 29.01.2020, under Sections 379 and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagadhri.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that 29 logs of Khair wood are alleged to have been recovered. He also contends that the petitioner has been implicated only on the basis of suspicion especially when the land from where the wooden logs were recovered is neither owned nor possessed by the petitioner.

Issue notice to the respondent.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Chetan Sharma, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.

List on 06.07.2020.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to appear

before the Investigating Officer and join investigation.

In the event of his arrest, the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer shall release the petitioner on ad-interim bail subject to his/her satisfaction. The petitioner shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ram Partap, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation, at this stage.

In view thereof, the order dated 12.05.2020 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
