The petitioners figure amongst the accused in FIR No. 142 dated 7.4.2020 on the file of Police Station Khol, District Rewari, Haryana, registered under Sections 147, 149, 341, 379-B, 506 and 188 IPC.

By way of this petition, they seek grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr. P.C.

Be it noted that though an offence was initially registered under the provisions of Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, the same was deleted thereafter in the course of the investigation. It may also be noted that the co-accused of the petitioners have already been granted regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. Perusal of the FIR does not disclose any serious and specific overt acts against the petitioners warranting their custodial interrogation at this stage. They would therefore be entitled to grant of

The petition is accordingly allowed directing release of the petitioners in the event of their arrest in FIR No. 142 dated 7.4.2020 on the file of Police Station Khol, District Rewari, Haryana, subject to each of the petitioners furnishing a personal bail bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- along with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) (i) (ii) and (iii) Cr. P.C.
