For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and affidavit of the sister of the petitioner, dated 15.05.2020, is taken on record.

CRM-M-12175- of 2020

The petitioner is seeking interim bail for the purpose of performing last rites of his mother who died on 20.04.2020. In the case in hand, 250 tablets and 2800 capsules of Spasmo Prosyvon Plus have been recovered from the petitioner which falls in the category of commercial quantity. Affidavit of Ms.Marsat, sister of the petitioner, has been placed on record which indicates that rituals are still pending, i.e., 4th day

ceremony, 1st Monday ceremony, 1st Friday, 15th day, 40th day ceremony and needs to be fulfilled by the said lonely son. It has been conceded that at present 40th day ceremony is required to be performed. The affidavit does not indicate as to who had performed the earlier ceremonies. The petitioner is resident of Sri Nagar and the death of his mother took place about 37 days ago and in such circumstances, no justified ground is made out to grant interim bail to the petitioner.
