The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.180 dated 23.09.2019, under Sections 353, 186, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends no overt act has been attributed to the petitioner and it is alleged that her husband had abused and tried to assault the employees of the PSPCL.

This Court, by the order dated 12.05.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sarbjeet Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 12.05.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
