The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.128 dated 12.03.2020, under Sections 147, 149, 323, 341 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Barwala, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is 21 years old student and a simple injury has been attributed to him.

This Court, by the order dated 12.05.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ram Phal, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but he is not cooperating and recovery has to be effected from him.

In view of the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 12.05.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
