The petitioner is one amongst the accused in FIR No. 31 dated 01.03.2020 on the file of Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran, registered under Sections 21 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the Act of 1985').

By way of this petition, he seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

The petitioner along with the co-accused were allegedly found in joint possession of heroin in excess of the commercial quantity prescribed under the Act of 1985.

Mr. H.S. Sullar, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, would assert that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is utmost necessary to gather further particulars. Given the aforesaid circumstances, this Court finds no ground to exercise jurisdiction under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
