The petitioner is one amongst the accused in FIR No. 210 dated 17.8.2019 on the file of Police Station City Moga, District Moga, registered under Section 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 448 and 120-B IPC.

By way of this petition, he seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

The individual offences alleged against the petitioner do not entail imprisonment in excess of seven years even if he is found guilty. This Court is informed that the co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted anticipatory bail on conditions. That being so, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner would also be entitled to grant of pre-arrest bail subject to conditions.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing release of the petitioner in the event of his arrest in FIR No. 210 dated 17.8.2019 on the file of Police Station City Moga, District Moga, subject to the petitioner furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- along with two

sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) (i) (ii) and (iii) Cr.P.C.
