This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.58 dated 30.03.2020, under Sections 307, 323, 186, 353, 188, 269, 270, 341, 148, 149, 120-B of IPC 1860 registered at Police Station, Dharamkot, District Moga.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Major Singh, informs that the co-accused of the petitioners have already joined investigation. In view of the said fact, the present petition is **disposed of** with a direction to the petitioners to join investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of their arrest, they shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer on their furnishing bail bonds/sureties to his satisfaction, subject to the conditions mentioned below as envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

1. that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the

facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

3. that the petitioners shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.
4. Such other condition as may be imposed under sub Section (3) of Section 437 as if the bail were granted under that Section.
