1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.167 dated 02.12.2019, registered under Section 379-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.
3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 13.05.2020, while issuing notice of motion and adjourning the case for 23.07.2020, it was ordered that in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he be released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer and that in terms of the aforementioned order, the petitioner joined investigation and has been released on ad-interim bail.
4. Learned Addl. AG, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Gurjit Singh, confirms the petitioner having joined investigation on 07.07.2020

and also of his having been released on ad-interim bail besides not being required for custodial interrogation.

5. In the light of the position as noted above, order dated 13.05.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute, qua the petitioner. The petitioner shall also abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
