Petitioner No.1 Manjit Kaur and Petitioner No.2 Varinder Singh have filed the present petition inter alia seeking protection of their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 18 and other family members and to restrain the private respondents from interfering in their peaceful life. Counsel for the petitioners by making reference to the pleadings submits that petitioner No.1 got married to respondent No.4 in the year 2014. It is further submitted that they have two children from the marriage. Learned counsel submits that petitioner No.1 was thrown out of matrimonial home and is staying with petitioner No.2. Learned counsel submits that till he seeks further remedy in accordance with law, there is threat to their life and liberty.

Counsel for the petitioners further submits that she has submitted a representation to Sr. Superintendent of Police, Patiala (P3).

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the matter and decide the representation filed by the petitioners within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
