The petition has been taken for hearing through video conference due to Covid-19 pandemic.

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 52, dated 23.04.2020, under Sections 379, 149, 188 IPC, registered at Police Station Taragarh, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of order passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court dated 14.05.2020.

Learned State counsel, who has also joined the proceedings through video conference, states that in terms of the previous order of this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and no further

interrogation is required.

In view of the above, the order dated 14.05.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.
