GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.51 dated 16.4.2020 at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur under Sections 452, 323, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that all the injuries in the present case have been declared as simple injuries and have allegedly been caused on non-vital parts i.e. on hand and elbow.
3. The learned State counsel has not disputed the aforesaid factum regarding nature and seat of injuries. The learned State counsel, upon instructions from

ASI Sukhdev Singh, has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court on 14.5.2020, the petitioners have since joined investigation.

4. Bearing in mind the nature and seat of injuries and the fact that the petitioners have since joined investigation, their custodial interrogation is not warranted. The petition, as such, is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 14.5.2020 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
