Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only.

Mr. Ankur Mittal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.

Petitioners have preferred this petition seeking a direction that respondent No.7 be restrained from carrying out mining operations in the area. According to learned counsel, mines and minerals are being extracted from the land in question in an illegal manner. Thus, necessary orders need to be passed by the writ court.

Learned State counsel, on the other hand, submits that Gram Panchayat, Village Rattewali, Teshil and District Panchkula has been called by the office of Deputy Commissioner, Panchkula where their grievances

In view of the aforesaid statement, we dispose of the writ petition with a direction that the Deputy Commissioner, Panchkula shall pass a speaking order after taking into consideration all the facts and circumstances of the case. Three representatives of the petitioners shall also be granted hearing by the Deputy Commissioner. The order be passed thereafter at the earliest, in any case, not later than two weeks.
