Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, namely, Angrej Singh, under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 30, dated 28.03.2019 registered under Sections 18/61 and 85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandha Rural.

At the outset, it must be noticed that the first bail application of the petitioner was dismissed on merits vide order dated 02.03.2020 while deciding CRM-M-19058 of 2019.

As per the case of the prosecution, 4 Kg. opium was recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner which falls in commercial category.

Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of lock-down.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is suffering from a serious disease of liver and lungs. He has also drawn

attention of the court to various applications filed by the petitioner before the learned trial Court in this regard and the orders passed.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State has submitted that in the present case the prosecution has already got recorded evidence of 7 prosecution witnesses out of total 15 proposed to be examined. He further submits that the recovery from the petitioner is huge and falls in commercial category.

Keeping in view, the aforesaid facts of the case, this court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner, at this stage.

However, the present petition is disposed of with the following directions:-

- (1) The Jail Superintendent is directed to get the petitioner medically examined from Government Hospital as and when recommended or advised by the doctor posted in Jail.
- (2) Learned trial court is requested to expedite disposal of the case.
