Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no instructions in relation to the compliance of previous order dated 08.07.2020, regarding the petitioner's undertaking to pay up the entire amount of ₹31 Lacs along with due interest @ 6% per annum, and that to the best of his information, the petitioner has failed to make any payment.

2. In view of the aforesaid submission, this Court has no other option but to pass an order, after the warning already issued by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on the last date, i.e. 16.10.2020, to the effect that “....*It has been made clear to counsel for the petitioner that in case the requisite demand draft is not furnished on the adjourned date, the instant revision petition would stand dismissed*”.
