After hearing both sides, the instant Writ Petition filed on behalf of two ladies, who are the mother and sister-in-law of one Iqbal Singh, who is stated to be absconder from law, is disposed off with a direction upon Respondents No.2 and 3 to ensure that the Petitioners are not unduly harassed or disturbed time and again by the Police Authorities in their residence by way of frequent unscheduled raids meant ostensibly to nab the aforesaid Iqbal Singh. However, the Police Authorities are at liberty to depute a small contingent not exceeding four Police Personnels preferably including some lady official therein, in or near the residential premises of the Petitioners so that the absconding Iqbal Singh may not have any scope to slip-away, if and when he visits the residential premises, at any time.
