Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner, in FIR No.338 dated 06.08.2019, under Sections 379-A, 420 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Civil Line, Kaithal.

At the outset, it has been pointed out by learned counsel for the petitioner that instead of pressing the petition for regular bail, he is praying for only an interim bail, in view of the fact that the real brother of the petitioner has expired today, i.e. 15.05.2020 and there is no other male member to perform the last rites.

Although learned State counsel is not in a position to ascertain the above factual position in view of the fact that demise has taken place today only, but taking into consideration the extreme urgency, this Court is inclined to grant one week interim bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition is disposed off and the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail forthwith till 22.05.2020 on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/ Duty Magistrate, concerned.

However, it is made clear that above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merit of the case in any manner.
