The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.128 dated 02.05.2020, under Sections 18/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Safidon, district Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused, from whom 82 grams of opium (non-commercial quantity) has been recovered.

This Court, by the order dated 15.05.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 15.05.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
