The learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Bhawna Police Station City Kapurthala, has made statement that in consequence of order dated 15.05.2020, the petitioner-Ranjit Kaur @ Renu has joined the investigation and that nothing has been recovered from her and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.05.2020 is made absolute till submission of report under Section

173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
