Dinesh and Mohit, accused in FIR No.53 dated 19.01.2020 registered at Police Station, Model Town, Panipat, District Panipat, for offence punishable under Sections 148, 149 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act (later on altered to Section 30 of said Act) pray for grant of regular bail.

Heard.

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Haryana.

Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana, appears on behalf of the State of Haryana.

The present is a case of no injury to the complainant. There was some money dispute between complainant Sheela and accused Ravinder @ Nanha.

Counsel representing the State, on instructions from ASI Krishan, would fairly concede that dispute between the parties has been

settled by way compromise. Challan has been presented in the Court. The co-accused namely Manjeet has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 12.05.2020 (Annexure P3).

Without commenting upon merits of the case, the petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, Panipat.

However, they shall abide by the following conditions:-

(i) They shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and

(ii) They shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.
