The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No.165 dated 17.03.2020 on the file of Police Station Ambala Cantt, registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 324 and 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959. By way of this petition, he seeks anticipatory bail.

By order dated 28.05.2020 passed in this case, this Court

directed the petitioner to appear before the investigating/arresting officer as and when required. This Court further directed that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner should be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the investigating/arresting officer. The petitioner was directed to comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Mr. Anant Kataria, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, would inform this Court, on the strength of the instructions given by Sub Inspector Jai Bhagwan, Police Station Ambala Cantt, that the petitioner joined the investigation pursuant to the aforestated order and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed directing the release of the petitioner in the event his arrest is warranted or required in FIR No.165 dated 17.03.2020 on the file of Police Station Ambala Cantt, upon his furnishing a personal bond along with two sureties to the satisfaction of the investigating/arresting officer. In such an event, the petitioner shall also abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
